Pen-Strip NPX is an acid activated solvent paint stripper that will rapidly attack and loosen even the toughest baked on paint finishes, it will strip virtually any paint or coating from its substrate.

Pen-Strip NPX can be used in a mild steel tank with lid to prevent solution loss caused by evaporation. Do not heat.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use procedure	Parts should be completely immersed until the paint is lifted from the surface. Remove parts and pressure rinse with water.
Concentration	Use undiluted.
Note	Pen-Strip NPX is safe on aluminum, bronze, chromium, iron and steel. Prolonged immersion is not recommended on brass, copper, tin, zinc, cadium and magnesium.

INCOMPATIBILITY

WAREHOUSING PRECAUTIONS

Do not store near oxidizing agents. Do not store in zinc, aluminum, aluminum alloys, or plastic.
