## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

### Use procedure

#### Bucket and Brush

Add 1 part **Penetone 169** to 25 parts water. Brush solution onto surface, agitating where necessary. Rinse with water.

#### High Pressure Spray

Add 1 part **Penetone 169** to 50 parts water, spray onto surface, allowing a short contact time. Pressure water rinse.

#### Automatic Washing Equipment

For transportation equipment, add 1 part **Penetone 169** to 50 to 128 parts water. Run equipment through machine cycle. Rinse with water.
