Abandonment Suspension Corrosion Inhibitor

OIL & GAS FLUID TREATMENT

PENETONE 2010C is a water-miscible "packer fluid" or "gunker", otherwise known as an abandonment suspension corrosion inhibitor, designed to inhibit corrosion in pipelines and wells that are no longer in use. **PENETONE 2010C** will effectively protect against bacterial, dissolved oxygen and acid gas attack as well as other forms of electrolytic corrosion.

For reduction of corrosive environments, batch volumes of **PENETONE 2010C** sufficient to fill discontinued flowlines are pumped into the well annulus and tubing and circulated after blending with fresh or produced water. In abandoned pipelines, similar corrosion control is achieved after pig train applications.

Treatment rates

DIRECTIONS FOR USI

Treatment rates will vary depending on location and situation. Typically, effective corrosion inhibition can be achieved with 0.5 to 1.5% v/v of **PENETONE 2010C** per m³ of fresh or produced water.

Volumes of **PENETONE 2010C** and water-diluent required for the abandoned flowlines or wells should be calculated from rate of corrosion data. For more agressive environments, higher concentrations of **PENETONE 2010C** may be required.

FIRST AID MEASURES
